## Overview

Are you interested in discovering more about online assessments? This workshop outlines different ways to assess in an online environment that will assist students in the learning process and allow teaching staff to monitor student progress and performance during a unit.

In this workshop participants will be able to:

1. Discuss key considerations when planning to assess online
2. Identify tools and strategies to support student assessment
3. Participate in focussed group activities to support online assessment strategies including:
  - Quizzes and monitoring student progress;
  - Online assignment submission and grading in vUWS;
  - Assessing group work; and

- Online assignment submission and grading using Turnitin.

The workshop will provide participants with the opportunity to explore the assessment tools used to create assessments and provide them with the knowledge to determine which tools best suit their educational and contextual assessment needs.
