Western Sydney University offers students **free** access to Clarity English, Lynda.com, and Study Smart Advisor Online with institutional subscriptions. To access these resources and services, simply follow the links and login instructions below:

Clarity English

Clarity English offers interactive learning programs for reading, grammar and academic writing, with four modules on:

- Business Writing
- Road to IELTS (for desktop and tablet only)
- Study Skills Success
- Tense Buster

For most modules (except 'Road to IELTS'), if you want to view them on an iOS mobile device you'll need to install the [Puffin Web Browser](#) app (free versions available for both iOS and Android).

You can [access Clarity English directly](#), or find Clarity English under 'C' in the Library's [eResources](#), and log in using your Western ID.

Lynda.com

Lynda.com offers self-paced online tutorials covering a range of software, technology, business and creative skills for personal and professional use. You can access CAD software for your engineering assignments, Microsoft Excel tutorials to master quantitative analysis for research, or Adobe Photoshop to build up your photography hobby experience. You should use Lynda.com to support your studies and prepare for your career pathways. Access is free for Western students using your Western email address

Study Smart Advisor Online

Study Smart Advisor Online is a SSAF funded service that provides accessible online educational support. This includes help with understanding content in selected subject areas (e.g. Maths, English, Science, History and Business Studies), general assignment writing support (e.g. essay, report, oral presentation), and a writing feedback service (*Checkmate*) offering a 24-hour turn-around.
