

## HUNT, Robert Edward

Robert Hunt studied for the Diploma for just one year during 1904. He was 17. He joined the 18<sup>th</sup> Battalion as a 28 year old grazier at the end of May 1915 and was only in camp for 4 weeks before embarking for Egypt on 19 June 1915. He sent a postcard to HAC on the 14<sup>th</sup> of August saying he was off to Gallipoli the following day. Hunt was posted missing subsequent to the charge on Hill 60 on 27 August and his body was found by a search party the following day. A witness later recounted that he was shot through the head at 5pm shortly after the attack commenced. He lies today in the Hill 60 Cemetery, Gallipoli, Turkey.
