



Executive Committee of the Research Studies Committee

1. Role

The Executive Committee of the Research Studies Committee determines urgent matters on behalf of the Research Studies Committee, between scheduled meetings of that Committee. All decisions made and actions taken by the Executive Committee are reported to the next meeting of the Research Studies Committee. This includes the approval of the conferring of higher degrees by research, where it is not practicable for the Research Studies Committee to meet.

2. Membership

Membership is as follows:

- a. Chair of the Research Studies Committee
- b. Deputy Chair of the Research Studies Committee
- c. One Director of Higher Degree Research from the University Research Institutes, nominated by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor and Vice-President, Research, Enterprise and International
- d. One Associate Dean, Higher Degree Research or equivalent from a School, nominated by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor and Vice-President, Research, Enterprise & International
- e. One other member of the Research Studies Committee, nominated by the Chair of the Research Studies Committee.

The appointment of nominated members will expire after two (2) years, and they cannot be appointed for more than two consecutive terms.
