Mass public gatherings of more than 500 people will be effectively banned across Australia, locking out crowds from the AFL, Rugby League and concerts as the government attempts to stop the spread of the coronavirus.

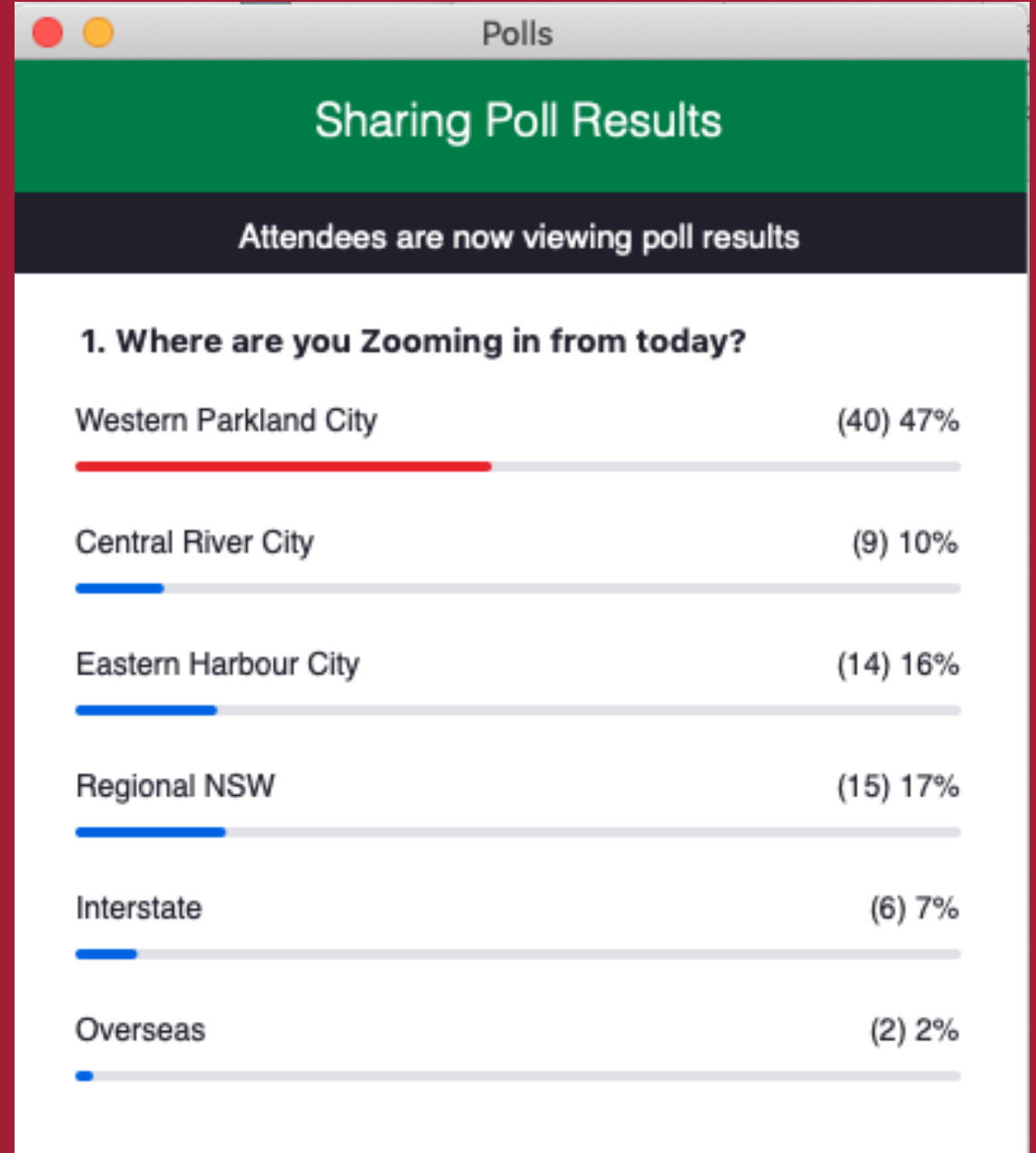

Birth-5 Years

- Provides an Early Childhood teaching qualification in 2 years or 1.5 years if WSU Bachelor of Early Childhood Studies, BA Pathway to EC teaching graduate with the option of study over Summer
- Includes curriculum and pedagogy birth-5, with strong focus on diversity and equity, partnerships with families, early intervention and pedagogical and community leadership

Birth-12 Years

- Provides an Early Childhood and Primary (K-6) teaching qualification in 2.5 years or 2 years for WSU pathway graduates
- Includes all of Birth - 5 plus an additional semester of primary curriculum and primary placement
- Provides a range of employment opportunities - early childhood is a growth area
