CAREER ADVICE:

What to do if a job asks 2+ years of experience?



The job search has begun, and you're now scrolling through 100's of job postings... only to feel deflated when noticing that most positions are asking for "minimum 2 or more years' experience".

Do not close the window, do not give up – take note of the following tips!

Experience is transferrable.

Its unlikely you have done the exact role before, but you may have done similar work through other projects or roles. Think specifically about what you did in things like:

Internships, Volunteer work, Club roles or Co-curricular programs.

Graduate roles and entry level roles are designed to give you experience.

Whilst a job listing may have a "wish list" or state that the "ideal candidate will have...". Recruiters are aware of their audiences and understand this may be your first full time role. Don't apologise for experience you don't have, but emphasize your passion for the role and industry, highlight your transferrable skills gained through other activities and how you are eager to learn from their organisation.

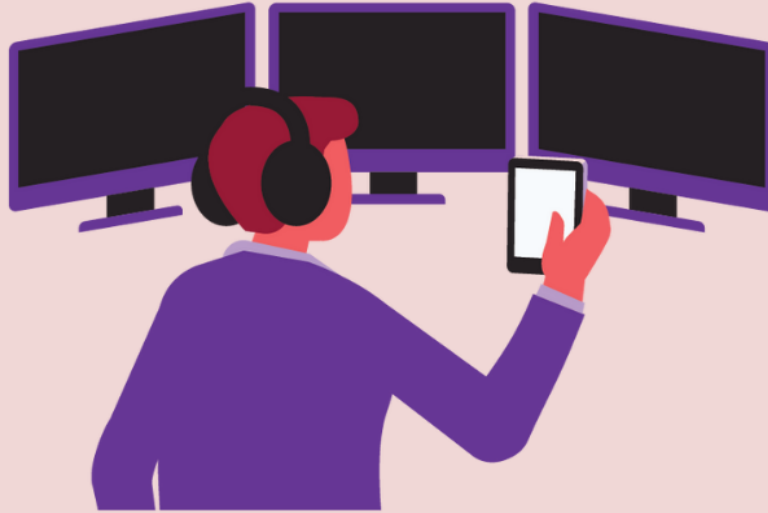
