Nomination of Candidates

Nominations must be submitted via the Student Elections Nomination Form and received by the Returning Officer by the close of nominations at 4.00 pm on Friday 11 August 2023. Nominations received after the close of nominations will not be considered.

Candidates should submit a photograph (passport size, head & shoulders jpeg/jpg file no larger than 200kb) and a candidate policy statement of no more than 200 words that will be made available to voters. These must be received by the Returning Officer by the close of nominations. Please note that each statement will be published with the candidate's name on both the Western Sydney University elections website, as well as the online voting portal. Candidates are also reminded that any material such as candidate's statements must comply with the requirements of Section 148 of the Student Representation Procedures. All candidates are reminded that they are subject to the University Code of Conduct in their electioneering. Eligibility

All candidates must be currently enrolled students of the University at the close of nominations. A candidate may nominate for up to six (6) positions on the Student Representative Council and/or as a Student Editor, but must indicate their preference on the Nomination Form. Candidates will only be eligible to hold one position either as a member of the Student Representative Council or as a Student Editor. Candidates may additionally nominate for a position as an NUS Representative.
