

BADUGULANG RESEARCH GRANTS 2022

WHAT ARE ASSESSORS LOOKING FOR?

Grants that can provide:

- **seed funding**, for proof of concept and pilot projects (usually around \$2,000)
- **extension funding**, for an established project which can incorporate a side-project meeting the grant criteria
- **launching large team-based projects** (up to \$10,000)

Highly regarded proposals will be **strategic, develop staff capability** and plan for **effective dissemination**.

It may be helpful to consider:

Is the proposal strategic?

- Does the research align with the teaching and learning strategic priorities of Western (e.g., digital uplift, Digital Learning Threshold Standards, flexible learning, student retention, transition, and success)?
- Is the research aligned with one or more of the institution-wide programs of research, including those with umbrella Human Ethics Approval ([START](#), [TEL PoR](#), [FLEX PoR](#), and [AIR](#))?

Does the proposal include planning and actions to develop staff capability in scholarship?

- Does the research involve mentorship and/or collaboration with Early Career Researchers, Mid-Career Researchers and/or Sessional Staff?
- Does the research plan and budget include professional development opportunities for one or more members of the research team?

Does the proposal include planning and actions to ensure effective dissemination?

- Does the research plan and budget include dissemination activities and opportunities involving one or members of the research team?
- Does the dissemination plan include activities that reach beyond the immediate context of the research (e.g., outreach to relevant disciplines and Schools; presentations within Western, presentations and publications external to Western).
