AGRICULTURAL COLLEGES.

TENNIS AND RIFLE MATCHES.

ADELAIDE, Wednesday.

July 21

Inter-agricultural college sports between teams from Gatton (Queensland), Hawkesbury (N.S.W.), Dookie (Vic.), and Roseworthy (S.A.) were begun at Roseworthy to-day, when teams competed in rifle shooting and tennis matches.

At tennis Hawkesbury defeated Roseworthy by 3 rubbers to 1; Dookie defeated Gatton, 3 to 1; Hawkesbury defeated Gatton, 3 to 1; and in an unfinished match, Dookie scored two rubbers to Roseworthy's one. Another rubber remains to be played.

The rifle shooting was won by Dookie with 541 points out of a possible 600. Gatton was second with 546, Hawkesbury had 547, and Roseworthy 535.

ADELAIDE, Thursday.

In the interstate tennis contests at Roseworthy College, between members of agricultural colleges, Dookie College (Victoria) beat Roseworthy (South Australia) by four rubbers to nil; Roseworthy beat Gatton (Qld.) by three rubbers to one, and Hawkesbury (N.S.W.) beat Dookie by three rubbers to one. Hawkesbury, with nine rubbers, won the tennis shield.
