

Documentation must comply with the formatting requirements (Refer to the Nomination instructions for details).

Submission must contain ALL required elements on the Nomination Checklist for documentation required for each award type.

Incomplete applications will not be assessed.

The Australian Awarded University Teaching Network (AAUTN), <u>Award Mentor Scheme</u> is available to assist in preparing the nomination.

Online submission is via the 2022 AAUT Awards Portal.

Phase 1: Nominee Registration

Enter nominee's details into the Awards Portal, and no documents need to be uploaded.

After the closing date, registered nominees can be withdrawn but no new registrations can be added. Ensure all information entered is correct.

Phase 2: Submission Upload

Upload <u>one PDF</u> submission for each nominee, along with a digital photograph.

Late submissions will NOT be considered after the closing date.

All submissions are to be uploaded by their ICO only.
