## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Receive a special New Colombo Plan (NCP) Mobility Grant of **up to AU\$9,500** to go on an exchange semester at one of our partner universities in India and complete an intensive study program equivalent of 30cps in the fields of Computer Science, Information and Communications Technology or Information Systems. Internship and language training options are also available for interested students. Spend time in this incredible country exploring one of the best tourist destinations of the world as it holds rich diversity in culture, food, language and attractions!

Option 1: Language training + semester long exchange program + internship (ISEO#26171)

NCP Mobility grant of AU9,500 available for 2 eligible students

Option 2: Semester long exchange program + internship (ISEO#20006)

NCP Mobility grant of AU8,000 available for 8 eligible students

## AM I ELIGIBLE FOR THIS EXPERIENCE?

To be eligible for this scholarship you must be:

- an Australian citizen from a non-Indian background
- enrolled in an undergraduate degree at Western Sydney University
- Must receive academic recognition for the experience

Note:

- Students who have previously received a New Colombo Plan Mobility Semester Grant are not eligible to receive another scholarship
- Students not meeting the criteria can still attend the program and may be eligible to receive other forms of financial assistance.



### WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

Students will complete an intensive study program that is equivalent to 30 credit points in the fields of **Computer Science, Information and Communications Technology or Information Systems**. Internship options are also available for interested students,

### WHERE WILL I BE STAYING OVERSEAS?

On-campus housing is available for undergraduate students on exchange.

### HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

As this is an exchange program, you will pay Western Sydney University course fees as per normal.

You will need to pay for:

- Flights;
- Accommodation;
- Meals;
- Visas;
- Vaccinations;
- Personal spending;

This cost may be offset by the New Colombo Plan Semester Grant (**up to AU\$9,500**), OS-HELP loan up to **\$8,295** and other financial assistance.

### WHAT IS THE NEW COLOMBO PLAN MOBILITY GRANT?

Eligible students participating in this program will receive a NCP Mobility Grant (**up to AU\$9,500**). The NCP is a signature initiative of the Australian Government which aims to lift knowledge of the Indo-Pacific in Australia by supporting Australian undergraduates to study and undertake internships in the region. In the situation that more applications are received than the number of grants available, we will require you to provide additional documents and information to be considered for the NCP Mobility Grant.

### WHAT IS OS-HELP?

You may be eligible for OS-HELP, a deferred HELP debt loan for undergraduate Australian citizens. Loans of **AU\$4,000** and **AU\$8,295** are available. Academic recognition is required; have completed 80 credit points of study, and have 10 credit points remaining on return.
