#### **BIOGRAPHY:**

**Hassan Gholipour Fereidouni** is an Associate Professor of Property in the School of Business at Western Sydney University (WSU) in Australia. Prior to joining WSU, he held Lecturer (2014-2017) and Senior Lecturer (2018-2020) positions in Economics at Swinburne University of Technology. Hassan is an active researcher in the fields of property economics, urban studies, tourism economics and Middle East economics, having published more than 100 journal articles since 2008. He is among Stanford/Elsevier's list of world top 2% scientists for the years 2020, 2021 and 2022.

#### **OBJECTIVE:**

The purpose of this workshop is to introduce participants to two globally recognized survey-based datasets: the World Bank Enterprise Surveys (WBES) and the World Value Survey (WVS). Despite their rich content, these datasets often remain underutilized due to limited awareness or understanding of their details. Associate Professor Hassan Gholipour Fereidouni, with his expertise demonstrated through seven published articles utilizing these datasets, will guide participants in effectively leveraging them for research purposes. Through this workshop, participants will gain insights into the potential of these datasets and learn how to utilize them effectively for their own research.

- Learn how to potentially avoid the need for extensive data collection processes, including ethics approval and data collection costs.
- Stimulate new research ideas by exploring the rich content of the WBES and WVS datasets.
