### Alignment with Tax Practitioners Board (TPB) Tax (Financial) Adviser and Tax Agent Registration Requirements

From 1 January 2016, those wishing to register as a Tax (Financial) Adviser or Tax Agent will be required to meet qualification and experience requirements as set out in [Schedule 2, Part 3 of the Tax Agent Services Regulations 2009 \(TASR\)](#).

The University has approval from the TPB to deliver courses in Australian tax law and commercial law for tax (financial) advisers and tax agents. The table below confirms the units that must be completed to satisfy the tertiary qualifications requirements to register as a Tax (Financial) Adviser or Tax Agent.
