The International Centre for Neuromorphic Systems (ICNS) is located at the Western Sydney University (WSU) Werrington South Campus.



Picture – Corporate Centre, Great Western Highway Entrance to WSU Werrington South Campus


Arriving by Car

Enter via either the Great Western Highway or O'Connell St as marked with an X on the below map. Note the entry road on the Great Western Highway is located between Gipps St and O'Connell St (just look for the big green building on the corner). If heading west towards Penrith, you will turn LEFT, or if heading east towards the city, you will turn RIGHT.

Entry to Building BA is via security doors located next to **Piccolo Me Cafe**. ICNS are located on Level 2 and you will need to call Kathy Glavas on 0417 470 152 upon arrival to gain entry.

Parking

Parking is available in two locations behind building BA as marked with the letter P. A parking permit will be issued upon arrival (if one has not been sent to you prior) and must be displayed on car dash.








Public Transport

If arriving by public transport, you can catch the Universities free shuttle bus service which operates between **(A) Kingswood rail station**, **(B) Kingswood (C) Werrington North** and **(D) Werrington South** Campus's. The bus runs on a continual loop approx. every 35 minutes. The shuttle stop is located behind the BA building on Werrington South Campus marked with an X on the below map.
