

# NATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON AUSTRALIAN TRADITIONAL MEDICINES (NSATM) 2024

## GENERAL RULES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Submission of abstracts for review is governed by the following rules established by the scientific committee of NSATM:

- Abstracts should be submitted on a topic relevant to Australian Indigenous Medicine in areas such as preclinical and clinical research, Indigenous cultural and intellectual property, regulation, commercialisation pathway, Indigenous governance and ethics, and supply chain and sustainability of raw ingredients.
- Abstracts must be submitted through the online submission system only (please *don't* email them to us).
- The presenting author must be registered for the symposium.

## PREPARING AND SUBMITTING YOUR ABSTRACT

The abstracts will undergo peer review by the NSATM Scientific Committee which will decide the suitability of the abstracts for either poster or short talk category. Preparing your abstract for submission includes several key elements. Please follow the following abstract template.

### ABSTRACT TEMPLATE

**TITLE:** The title should clearly identify the contents of the abstract.

**AUTHORS:** Capital the first letter of the First name and Surname (e.g., John Smith). Use underline and asterisk (\*) to specify the Presenting and Corresponding authors, respectively.

**AFFILIATIONS:** Capitalise the first letter of Each Word for affiliations (e.g., Western Sydney University) followed by the address (e.g., Westmead, NSW 2145, Australia).

**EMAIL ADDRESS:** Please add the email addresses of the First, Presenting and Corresponding authors.

**ABSTRACT TEXT:** The main text of each abstract should consist of no more than 300 words. The text should contain- 1) Objective, 2) Methodology, 3) Results and 4) Conclusions. The text should be in Times New Roman font; size 12, single-spaced. Please write symbols in the extended form (e.g., "α" should be written as "alpha"). The abstract should not contain any tables, figures, or graphics.

**KEYWORDS:** Add up to five relevant keywords.
