ABOUT THE BRSC

The BRSC is constituted to:

- advise the Senior DVC and Vice-President (Research, Enterprise and Global) on matters regarding genetic manipulation, biological and radiation safety compliance and policy matters;
- minimise biological and radiation risk, and ensure compliance with the *Gene Technology Act, Protection from Harmful Radiation Act*, and the *National Security Act* as they apply to the University:
- recommend appropriate training for personnel using radioactive materials and equipment, and high-powered

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP?

The committee includes:

- a representative from Work Health Safety & Wellbeing (WHS&W);
- a specialist in radiation safety;
- a representative from the Division of Operations and Commercial (O&C) and
- an independent member.

In addition, four to six other staff and academic members will be appointed to the committee with expertise in:

- molecular biology, biochemistry;
- plant pathology, plant physiology, plant genetics;
- microbiology, immunology, infectious diseases;
- · health sciences:
- medicine, pharmacology; and/or
- laboratory maintenance and functionality.

FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS

Meeting are held on a six (6) weekly cycle. Meetings are held at the various WSU campuses at 10am. As required, facility inspections are conducted after the meetings.

DURATION OF APPOINTMENT

Members are appointed for three (3) years and will commence from January 2025 until January 2028.
