LEADERSHIP

Lead their Curriculum Challenge Team.

Mentor early career academics in their Curriculum Challenge Team to develop their curriculum capabilities.

Contribute to the development of a collegial and collaborative 21C culture at Western Sydney University.

Work with other Curriculum Challenge Champions to share expertise and collaborate on the implementation of 21C curricula.

IMPACT

Each Curriculum Challenge Team will deliver:

- 2 x 21C Sub-Majors (Minors)
- 3-5 21C Curiosity Pods in each Sub-Major
- Renewal of a 21C combined double degree

Drawing on Partnership Pedagogy, the Curriculum Champion will collaborate with transdisciplinary teams of staff, students and partners to create new 21C curricula for our flexible degree architectures that will:

- develop a new type of graduate with the transdisciplinary 'hybrid' capabilities needed for success in a disrupted future of work and society
- provide more attractive degree choices
- build local and global partnerships
- help to deliver on the University's commitment as a global institution and as an anchor institution in Greater Western Sydney.
