

Sanctions under the Student Misconduct Rule

The following are actual examples of sanctions that students have received if they have been found to have engaged in academic or general misconduct:

MISCONDUCT BEHAVIOUR	SANCTION
Where individual work is required: making or receiving available notes, papers or answers related to the content of an examination or assignment	Temporary exclusion from the unit for 2 teaching sessions Fail for the unit Direction to undertake StudySmart academic literacy sessions with the Library Direction to provide a written undertaking not to repeat behaviour
Copying another student's answers or improperly obtaining or sharing answers	Reduction of mark in Assessment to zero Direction to complete the Academic Integrity Module and Quiz Direction to provide written apology Direction to provide a written undertaking not to repeat behaviour
Submission of work that is not student's own, or, where ideas or other work are taken from a source and presented as if these are the student's own work, without appropriate acknowledgement citations	Fail in the unit Direction to complete the Academic Integrity Module and Quiz Direction to provide written apology Direction to provide a written undertaking not to repeat behaviour
Unauthorised material in examination or assessment, either in person or online	Reprimand Reduction of mark in Assessment to zero Direction to complete the Academic Integrity Module and Quiz
Submission of a fraudulent document, eg medical certificate, death certificate, statutory declaration	Suspension from the University for one or more teaching sessions Fail for the unit Reprimand
Uploaded documentation to an information sharing website, such as assignment/assessment documents, study notes, lecture slides etc	Temporary Exclusion from course for one or more teaching sessions Fail for the unit Direction to provide a written undertaking not to repeat behaviour Reprimand
