The International Conference on Engineering Education and Research, 2016 (ICEER 2016) is jointly organised by the School of Computing, Engineering and Mathematics at Western Sydney University, Sydney, Australia and the International Network for Engineering Education and Research (iNEER).

iNEER is a global professional organisation formed by the world engineering community to promote mutual progress in teaching and learning through international cooperation. iNEER is a non-profit organisation based in Potomac, Maryland, USA. The widening network of educators and researchers associated with iNEER covers 98 countries and

is linked through the iNEER website, archival publications, electronic communication system and various conferences, workshops and retreats worldwide.

ICEER 2016 will be hosted at Western Sydney University's Parramatta Campus which is situated on the Parramatta River, 20km from the Sydney CBD and is well connected by rail, road and ferry networks.
