

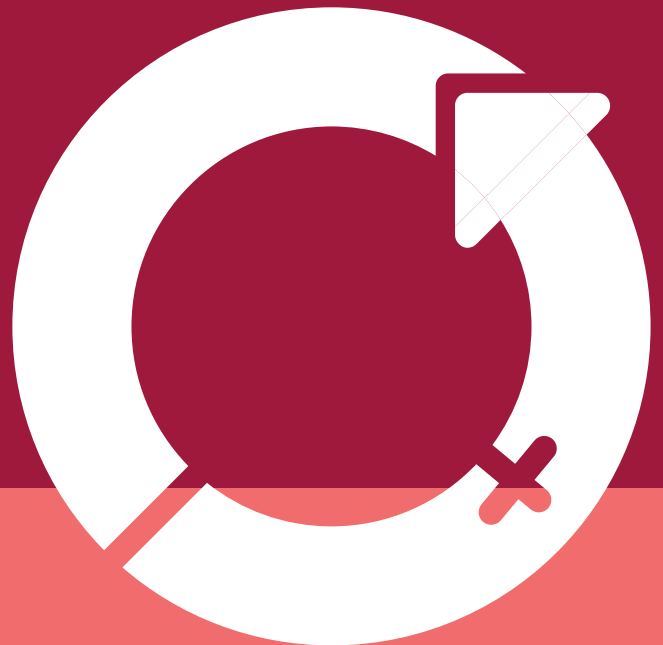

President of the Auburn Giants Australian Football Club - and founder of the first womens AFL team in Western Sydney, Amna is widely recognised for the diversity she brought to the game and for taking the code to Western Sydney pioneering programs for women from minority communities. Amna derives her strength from adversity and uses her influence to change the conversation on gender, culture, intersectionality, faith and representation.

An active leader in the community, she's also worked for the Australian Federal Police in community engagement collaborating with community leaders, small business owners and local government, and has served on numerous government boards.
