

Careers Consultant Says:

Research shows employers in 2022 used a wide range of methods to recruit. Advertising on internet job boards is the most common method of finding staff with almost two-thirds of recruiting employers using this method in 2022.

One in seven recruiting employers (14%) did not advertise their most recent vacancy and only used word of mouth and/or considered job seekers who approached the business directly.
