#1 Plastics
(PET)



Glass bottles
and jars



Look for
this logo



#2 Plastics
(HDPE)



Steel cans



Aluminium cans



#5 Plastics
(PP)



Paper & cardboard
(if no dedicated bin available)



Liquid paperboard
cartons



Check the bottom of your plastic container or bottle to get
the Plastic Identification Code (the number in the triangle).
If it is plastic number 1,2 or 5 then it belongs in the Mixed Recycling bin.

Rule of thumb: If you are unsure whether an item is recyclable or not, check the sticker on your recycling bin. If you are still unsure put it into General Waste to prevent potentially contaminating the Mixed Recycling Bin.
