If so, you should consider enrolling in Law Honours.

200700 Law Honours Dissertation is a year-long 20 credit point unit which provides students with the opportunity to develop their legal research and writing skills and to produce a 8,000 to 10,000 word thesis. Honours in Law requires a minimum GPA of 5.5 for all law units. The calculation of the Honours Award level is based on the results of your thesis and your overall GPA.

Interested students should contact the School Honours Coordinator, Simon Kozlina, or a staff member you might want to work with, to discuss topics and eligibility.
