

COVID-19 EXPOSURE RESPONSE GUIDELINES (STAFF AND STUDENTS)

SITUATION	Brief or distanced contact with a COVID positive person	Spent some time with a person who has COVID	Significant period in close contact without PPE	Live with someone who has tested positive
CONTACT LEVEL	Walked past them, case alert from Service NSW App, attending the same location at different times, etc	Practical class, tutorial, lunch, dinner, social functions, research interview or focus group, etc	Spent a long time with COVID positive person: overnight stay, evening indoors, large amount of research work, driving for a long period, minding COVID- positive children, lengthy interactions without masks, etc	Same Household: if unable to separate from the COVID positive person, required to self-isolate with them until they are released from isolation
RISK LEVEL	LOW	MODERATE	HIGH	HIGH
MONITOR FOR SYMPTOMS	✓	✓	✓	✓
CAN ATTEND CAMPUS	✓	✓	✗	✗
ISOLATE FOR 7 DAYS FROM LAST CONTACT WITH POSITIVE PERSON	✗	✗	✓	✓
TEST IMMEDIATELY AND ON DAY 6	✗	✓	✓	✓
LEAVE ISOLATION AFTER 7 DAYS	No isolation needed	No isolation needed	If day 6 test is negative	If day 6 test is negative. Cannot visit high-risk settings for a further 7 days

Staff must ensure that students have support mechanisms in place to ensure they have continuation of learning if they are in isolation.
