INTERNSHIP COSTS

- → A typical 3-month internship project costs \$15,000, which includes \$9,000 stipend to the doctoral intern and the rest covers the contract administration and supervision costs.
- → Businesses in some sectors may be eligible for internship subsidies.

- → Work on real-life problems relevant to their area of research.
