

Terms and Conditions - Western Sydney University Open Day 2026 Registration

(Question-Answer Competition)

1. Entry to this competition is open to all prospective students who register for the Western Sydney University Open Day 2026 event (www.westernsydney.edu.au/openday), via the registration form. Employees of the University, any related corporation of the University or any agency involved in promoting this competition (and their immediate families) are ineligible to enter. Each entry must be entered in accordance with these terms and conditions. By entering this competition, each entrant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions. The University may in its discretion refuse to award any prize to any entrant who fails to comply with these terms and conditions.
2. Entry into this competition is free.
3. To be eligible to enter this competition, all entrants must complete the Open Day online registration form. Incomplete or incomprehensible entries will be ineligible for acceptance into the competition. This is the only method of entry into this competition.
4. A link to the online registration form will be available on the Western Sydney University Open Day 2026 event website.
5. There is a limit of one entry per person.
6. Entrants may only enter themselves in this competition. Each entrant warrants to the University that his or her entry is his or her own and is complete and accurate. If a prize recipient is under 18 years of age, they must nominate a parent or guardian to open a GiftPay account on their behalf, in order to access the prize.
7. This competition expires on Sunday 5 July at 4pm.
8. Any entry received after expiry of the competition period will be invalid. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected entries. All entries become the property of the University and will not be returned.
9. Winners of the competition will be advised via email by Friday 17 July 2026.
10. The winning entry will be drawn at random by Friday 17 July 2026. The competition is being held by the University's Office of Student Experience and Marketing on behalf of Western Sydney University. All decisions made in relation to this prize draw are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. The University reserves the right to make a lesser number of or no awards if not satisfied with the entries received.
12. If anything occurs that prevents or hinders the University's ability to conduct the competition or to deliver the prize to the prize winner, the University may, in its

discretion, cancel the competition and recommence it at another time under the same terms and conditions or select another winner.

13. The University is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information or other errors (whether technical or otherwise) that may occur in the course of conducting this competition. The University accepts no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to or alteration of entries.
14. To the full extent permitted by law, the University will not be liable for any injury, damages, expenses, or loss whatsoever (whether direct or inconsequential) to persons or property as a result of any person entering into the competition or accepting or using the prize.
15. The University reserves the right, at any time, to independently verify the validity of any entry or claim for the prize (including, without limitation, identity and other personal details of the entrant), and to reject that entry or claim if it cannot be verified to the University's satisfaction.
16. Any entrant who submits an entry or claim for the prize that is false or is not in accordance with these terms and conditions, or who tampers with the competition process in any way, will be automatically disqualified.

The University collects personal information in order to conduct this competition and may, for this purpose, disclose that information to third parties including agents, contractors, service providers, prize suppliers and, if required, to Australian regulatory authorities.
