## Who & Why

Girls' Tech Day Sydney is open to all female students in Years 4-12. The event is designed to engage students who may not yet see themselves in technology, as well as those already curious about STEM. For many students, Girls' Tech Day is their first step into the world of STEM. The event helps them see that careers in technology - both technical and non-technical - are within reach. Whether they're passionate about science, creativity, problem-solving, or leadership, there's a place for everyone in the future of technology.

## Cost & School Support

This is a fully funded opportunity. Participation is free for schools, and return bus transport is provided. We encourage each school to fill a bus (around 40 students) to ensure as many girls as possible can take part. Schools will also be provided with a Risk Assessment, and supported via a direct POC to ensure participation is easy and rewarding.

Throughout the day, students will:

- Take part in hands-on activities that showcase the real-world applications of STEM
- Explore an exhibition of companies, universities, and innovators using technology in exciting ways
- Hear from inspiring role models about their journeys in tech
- Discover emerging STEM careers in a creative, supportive environment
- Connect with mentors shaping the future of technology
- See how tech skills apply to every career, from art and sport to sustainability and design
