You need to complete 240 credit points including:

- 40 credit points BA Core
- 80 credit points First Teaching Area Major
- 40 credit points Second Teaching Area Minor
- 40 credit points Education Studies Secondary Teaching Minor
- 40 credit points Electives

At The College you complete 40 credit points in the BA Core and 40 credit points of Electives.

You will need to choose a First Teaching Area major from the list in the Handbook.

You will also need to choose a Second Teaching area major or minor from the list in the Handbook.

You need to select your First Field of Study major from those listed in the Handbook.

You also need to choose a Second Field of Study minor.
