Notice of Ballot

In accordance with the University's [Academic Staff Agreement 2022-2025](#) and the [Elections Policy](#), this notice advises that a ballot is being conducted to elect academic staff representatives to School Work Plan Committees.

Following the close of nominations, the number of valid nominations received exceeded the number of available positions on several Committees. As a result, a ballot is required for these positions.

Voting is being conducted via the BigPulse online voting system during the period specified at items (E) and (F) in the Key Information Table above.

Voting is now open.

Eligibility to Vote

Eligible voters within each School will receive an email containing a personalised, secure voting link from the Returning Officer – Western Sydney University (via a BigPulse domain).

To be eligible to vote, a person must be included on the Roll of Academic Staff for the relevant School as at the close of nominations (D).

An *employee* is defined under the *Academic Staff Agreement 2022–2025* as an academic staff member of the University employed on an ongoing, fixed-term, or casual basis and covered by the Agreement.
