IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Advice to Authors

Option A - Under this option, the author grants the University a licence to make the thesis openly available in ResearchDirect where it may be viewed and downloaded without further permission from the author. The descriptive details including the abstract may also be shared with external databases. The thesis remains protected by the Australian Copyright Act 1968. It is expected that most authors will elect this option, as normally there is no reason to restrict access to a thesis.

Option B - Under this option, only the descriptive details including the abstract will be made available in ResearchDirect during the specified embargo period. On the embargo end date, full access to the thesis will be permitted (as per Option A). The restriction period will not usually exceed one (1) year, unless suitable justification is approved. In order to extend the restriction beyond the maximum three (3) years, the author must complete a new Right of Access to HDR Thesis form.

Option C - Under this option, the full thesis will be permanently excluded from ResearchDirect. Only the descriptive details including the abstract will ever be available. This option should only be applied in extreme cases where it is important to protect the content of the thesis, such as for intellectual property or ethics reasons.

Non-thesis/Non-textual Components - If your thesis includes a non-thesis/non-textual component (such as a creative component), the Library will contact you to discuss access options. For example, you may choose to only provide access to your exegesis, or you may have work in other file formats (such as music, photographs or artwork) that you would like to make available.

Requests to Access a Restricted Thesis

If a request to access the thesis for the purposes of private study or research is received during the specified embargo period, the University Library must obtain the approval of the appropriate School Dean or Institute Director before copying or making the thesis available. Where possible, the author of the thesis will be consulted when a request has been made to provide an individual with access.

Copyright

The University Library can make a copy or communicate a copy of an unpublished thesis without infringing copyright, if the user requires the copy for the purposes of research or study as set out in **Section 51 (2) Copyright Act, 1968**:

"If the manuscript, or a reproduction, of an unpublished thesis or other similar literary work is kept in a library of a university or other similar institution, or in an archives, the copyright in the thesis or other work is not infringed by the making or communication of a reproduction of the thesis or other work by or on behalf of the officer in charge of the library or archives if the reproduction is supplied (whether by communication or otherwise) to a person who satisfies an authorized officer of the library or archives that he or she requires the reproduction for the purposes of research or study."

Western Sydney University retains the right to restrict public access to a thesis held by the University Library, if the author of a thesis has placed an embargo as per the conditions in 'Section 4 – Declaration'.

Third Party Copyright Content
