- ☐ Evidence
- ☐ In-text citations

Conclusion

- ☐ Summary of main points
- ☐ Restatement of thesis
- ☐ Concluding statement

Reference list

- ☐ Listed in alphabetical order
- ☐ Each entry follows the sequence and formatting for the same referencing style (e.g. APA, Harvard, Chicago) (For help: [Referencing & Citation guide](#))

Content
