ENTRY TO WESTERN

The ATAR isn't the only way to receive a university offer. Western offers a range of entry options to help students reach their unlimited potential.

Some of Western's creative programs provide alternative entry pathways for students that show exceptional merit in the field of their chosen degree. Music applicants can receive an offer based on an audition; Architecture, Design and Visual Communication students can receive an offer based on the submission and assessment of a portfolio.

Western also participates in the Schools Recommendation Scheme, where Year 12 students can receive an early offer based on their performance in Year 11 and their school's recommendation

HSC True Reward

Our HSC True Reward early offer program will give school leavers much needed peace of mind, providing students with an early offer into most university courses based on their Year 11# or Year 12 results, rather than scaled ATAR. It is open to both domestic and onshore international students.

Adjustment Factors

Students can boost their application strength and receive up to 10 adjustment factors (formerly known as bonus points) for entry to Western. Adjustment factors can be applied for living in the Western Sydney region, academic achievement in relevant subjects, disadvantage, elite athlete status, veteran and more.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Pathway Program

The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Pathway Program is an alternative entry pathway for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, providing prospective students with the opportunity to receive an early offer.

Applicants are required to sit literacy and numeracy assessments as well as have the opportunity to attend an academic consultation to discuss their course options.

Assessments can be delivered online or face to face.

This program is available for school leavers and non current school leavers.

Scholarships

Each year, Western offers \$20 million in scholarships for a generous range of University, government and donorfunded opportunities. There are over 100 scholarships across four categories:

- → Indigenous scholarships: Dedicated to providing opportunities for academically gifted Indigenous Australian students
- → High potential scholarships: Recognising academic achievement, leadership qualities, exceptional talent, elite athletes and Western high school program participants
- → Equity scholarships: Providing support for students from equity and educationally disadvantaged backgrounds
- → Humanitarian scholarships: Enabling refugees and asylum seekers to achieve their dreams.
