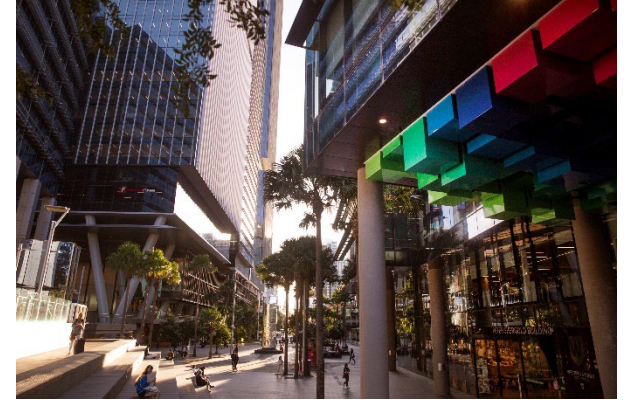
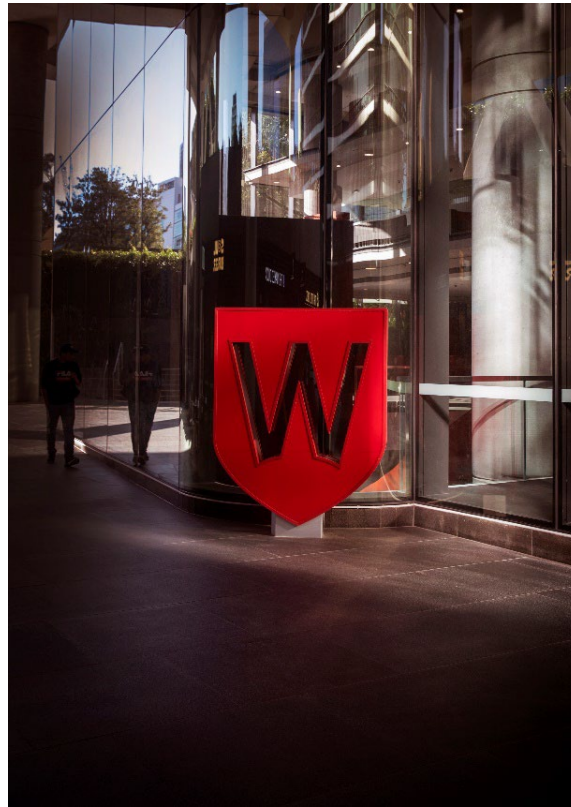
## Key Features
