

India: Chennai: Expect disruption during protest by state-ruling party on 18 February

#### **OVERVIEW**

**Event Date:** 18 Feb 2025

Expect disruption on **18 February** in Chennai (Tamil Nadu state) during a protest by the state-ruling Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam party and its allies. Protesters will gather at **16.00** (local time) outside the <u>Chennai Collectorate</u>. The event is being held to denounce the federal government and its alleged inadequate funding for Tamil Nadu in the country's annual budget.

#### ADVICE

 Expect traffic disruption around the Chennai Collectorate. If due to travel near the affected area, reconfirm the status of routes before setting out and allow additional travel time.

Mexico: Defer travel to coastal areas of Guerrero, Michoacan states following resurgence of Tropical Storm John until at least 28 September; essential travel to impacted areas of Oaxaca state can resume with precaution

#### **OVERVIEW**

Location: Chiapas, Guerrero, Michoacán, Oaxaca states - Mexico
 Category: Storm, Flood, Landslide, Transport disruption, Infrastructure outage

Last Updated: 25 Sep 2024 23:06 (GMT)

Defer travel to coastal areas of Guerrero and Michoacan states **until at least 28 September** following the resurgence of Tropical Storm John earlier on 25 September. Travel to impacted areas of Oaxaca state can resume with precaution following the storm's passage. The weather system is currently located south-west of Acapulco (Guerrero state). Afterwards, John is forecast to strengthen into a Category 1 hurricane (lowest on a five-tier scale) before making a second landfall late on **26 September** in the vicinity of <u>Zihuatanejo</u> (Guerrero).

#### **ADVICE**

#### Inbound travellers

- Defer all travel to coastal areas of Guerrero and Michoacan states until at least 28 September after the
  passage of Tropical Storm John, when the impacts on critical infrastructure and the security situation in
  the state will be clarified.
- Essential travel to impacted areas of Oaxaca state can resume with precaution following the passage of Tropical Storm John. Expect residual disruption and ensure routes are clear prior to setting out. Allow additional time for journeys and do not attempt to cross flooded roads. If you come upon one, find an alternative route to your destination.
