Out Of weighting is <u>NOT</u> your *ASSESSMENT WEIGHTING* and the **OUT OF MARK** (Raw Marks) is the *GRADING WEIGHTING* you have set for the Assessment.

The **SMS Assessment Item** area is your ASSESSMENT TYPE and approved when you submitted your D18 to SAC. The 'Out of' in this area is generated from Banner. The Assessment weighting can only be altered with a Subject variation approval by SAC, but you can request the 'Out of' weighting be altered, by contacting the SMS team or submitting a Ticket to WesterNow.

The **Grade Centre Column** area of the table is where You choose the Totals columns in the Grade Centre that matches the Assessment under the SMS Assessment Item.

The 'Out Of Mark' area DOES NOT have to match the grade for the SMS Assessment Item area, so long as Banner/SMS is told what the 'Out Of Mark' is when mapping in EDMM.

The grading scale for each Assessment type should be correctly set up in Data Clean Up (DCU), but the *Out of Mark* can be edited to suit your grading mark when mapping in EDMM. This alteration only affects this semester's grading and will not change the default, so when you roll your vUWS site to a new semester, you will be required to edit the grading mark again. If this is the grading mark you will be using each semester, you should submit a ticket to WesterNow to have the grading mark permanently altered (not the Subject assessment weighting).

You do not need to do a weighting calculation as Banner **WILL DO** the weighting calculation for you.


For example:

- The Task 2 assessment essay listed under SMS Assessment Item as being marked out of 40.
- You used a Rubric with 100 marks,
- Say the student received a score of 79.
- You leave a score of 79 marks in the Essay column in the Grade Centre
- BUT in the 'Out of Mark' column, you would change the 40 to 100.
- Banner/SMS will do the conversion back to a Subject assessment weighting of 40%, which is not shown here.

1. Click on **EDMM** – at the top right of the screen when you are in the vUWS Dashboard or your Subject site.


4. You will need to map the **Total columns from the Grade Centre** to the listed Assessment under the SMS Assessment Item area.




The 'Out of Mark' is the grading mark you used for each Assessment.
