- Log into your <u>myGov</u> account or use the <u>Express Plus Medicare mobile app</u>
- 2. Download a copy of your immunisation history statement and *remove your IHI number*. Or attach other vaccination evidence you might have.
- Attach your evidence with a colour copy of your Student ID card to the WesternNOW form (less than 2MB in size) and submit - easy!



INFLUENZA (FLU) AND COVID-19 VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

COVID-19 and influenza (flu) vaccinations are mandatory requirements for students attending a placement in any NSW Health facility. Students should be aware that without these vaccinations, placements may be cancelled and your compliance status may change.

WHEN DO I NEED TO GET A FLU VACCINATION?

Students attending NSW Health placements are required to have a current southern hemisphere influenza vaccination each year, available from April, and **recorded by NSW Health** before 1 June each year. Annual influenza vaccine is mandatory for all Category A Students (at their own cost) if attending a placement between 1 June and 30 September.

HOW MANY COVID-19 VACCINATIONS DO I NEED?

The current NSW Health requirements is for students who are considered Category A workers, to have at least two (2) vaccinations. Always check the latest advice. **Click here** for more Information.

WHEN DO I NEED TO GET THIS DONE BY?

COVID-19 vaccinations are available all year round and can be submitted at any time. Influenza vaccinations should be undertaken as soon as the current year's southern hemisphere vaccine is available, as early as March.

<u>Submit your influenza vaccination evidence</u> by the second Sunday in May (Mothers' Day) to prevent and changes to your upcoming placement.

WHAT IS THE REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF BEING VACCINATED?

 For COVID and/or flu - recorded on a MyGov Immunisation History Statement (AIR).

OF

 For flu - recorded directly onto your Vaccination Record Card - must include name & batch number and date of vaccine administered, signature of the administrator, practice stamp of the administrator.

OR

For flu - recorded on a separate document - such as GP Immunisation List, a pharmacy vaccination slip, a NSW Health staff clinic slip - must include your student name, DOB, name & batch number and date of vaccine administered, signature of the administrator, practice stamp of the administrator or on official stationery of the vaccine provider.

WHAT NEXT?

Scan your Student ID card PLUS your evidence <u>in colour</u> and collate to a single .pdf file less than 2MB in size then you're ready to resubmit.
